Ant 397R Directed Reading / Ant 497R Directed Research

397R Directed Reading: student conducts readings on a specific topic toward the goal of mastering a particular subject area under the supervision of a faculty mentor.

497R Directed Research: can include work in a lab; collecting, working with, or analyzing data; or other research activities decided on by the faculty and student.

Instructions: The “ANT 397R/497R Instructor” must be an Anthropology faculty or associated faculty, and will be the instructor of record for the course enrollment. If the work is being conducted directly under an Anthropology faculty member, that faculty member will serve as the ANT 397R/497R instructor. If the work is being conducted outside of Anthropology, the student must identify an Anthropology faculty sponsor to serve as the ANT 397R/497R instructor. This will typically be the Director of Undergraduate Research (DUR), but may be any Anthropology faculty member.

Once an instructor has been identified, the student must work with them to complete this form, and return it to the Undergraduate Program Coordinator (UPC) via email or to the Anthropology Department Office (Anth 207) by the end of the add/drop period of the semester in which the student will be enrolled. Requests will be reviewed by the DUR, and if approved, the UPC will process the enrollment.
